- Neurovascular interventions include acute stroke treatment, carotid stenting, intracranial aneurysm treatment, intracranial AVM, and dural AFV treatment
- Vascular embolization procedures include prostate artery embolization, uterine fibroid embolization, varicocele embolization, hemorrhoid embolization, geniculate artery embolization, and emergency embolization
- Venous interventions include treatment of varicose veins by glue embolization (VenaSeal)/thermal ablation/percutaneous sclerotherapy, acute DVT treatment, recanalization of chronic DVT, and May-Thurner syndrome
- Peripheral vascular disease recanalization, Diabetic foot salvage, and prevention of limb amputation
- Onco-interventions including TACE/RFA for liver cancer, RFA for osteoid osteoma, preoperative embolization, and guided biopsies
- Gastrointestinal and Hepatobiliary interventions like embolization for GI bleed, TIPS PTBD. BRTO for gastric varices
